## **Summary of Highest Counts of Individuals for Canada**

A record 303 species were reported from Canadian Christmas Bird Counts this year; another five were seen only in count week. A Lazuli Bunting seen at Cape Sable Island, NS, was new to the all-time count list for Canada. All-time high counts were set or tied for a further 40 species, shown in boldface numbers below. Seventy species, italicized in the following report, were high counts for all of North America this year. As usual, most high counts (157) were from British Columbia; Ontario tallied 83 and Nova Scotia 32. Victoria, BC, was tops among circles with 37 high counts while Ladner, BC, had 20.
